SECRETARY'S REPORT: The Secretary's minutes of July 9th, 2024 meeting was motioned by Joe Miriello and second by Joe Petrovich. (3-0) Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: – The Treasurer's report of August 13,2024 was reviewed. Councilman Miriello motioned to approve the report with President Petrovich second the motion. (3-0) Motion carried.

CODE REPORT: The demolition bids for 343 E. Warsaw Street were opened and are under review. One dumpster permit was issued, five notices of violations, three tickets issued, one complaint and one citation with hearing and was found guilty.
