

ORDINANCE No. 65

Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Marion Heights, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, and is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: As used in this chapter the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

CAMPER---A separate vehicle designed for human habitation and which can be attached or detached from a pickup truck.

CAMPER-TRAILER---A vehicular portable dwelling structure designed to be used for recreational purposes. This includes a travel trailer so identified by the manufacturer; a pickup camper; a folding tent trailer; and a motorized camper where the camping portion is an integral part of the self-propelled vehicle.

MOTOR HOME---A self-contained vehicle designed for human habitation with its own motive power and with a passageway from the body of the home to the driver's and front passenger's seat.

TRAILER---A vehicle without motive power designed for carrying persons or property on its own and to be drawn by a vehicle with motive power.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to park any camper, camper-trailer, motor home or trailer on any residential street within the Borough of Marion Heights for a period in excess of seven (7) days.

SECTION 3: No person, firm or corporation shall park a truck,

trailer, motor home, camper-trailer, camper or pickup truck with a gross weight in excess of one and one-half tons upon any road, street or highway within the Borough of Marion Heights unless that person, firm or corporation is engaged in a business or occupation which requires the temporary presence of said vehicle upon the streets of the Borough of Marion Heights. At the conclusion of said business the vehicle shall be moved from the streets of the Borough of Marion Heights.

SECTION 4: It shall be unlawful to occupy any camper-trailer or motor home for living or sleeping purposes or to cause any such vehicle to be connected to electric, water, gas or sanitary sewer facilities within the streets of the Borough of Marion Heights.

SECTION 5: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this chapter shall be fined not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

ORDINANCE No. 65

Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Marion Heights, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, and is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: As used in this chapter the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

CAMPER---A separate vehicle designed for human habitation and which can be attached or detached from a pickup truck.

MOTOR HOME---A self-contained vehicle designed for human habitation with its own motive power and with a passageway from the body of the home to the driver's and front passenger's seat.

TRAILER---A vehicle without motive power designed for carrying persons or property on its own and to be drawn by a vehicle with motive power.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to park any camper, camper-trailer, motor home or trailer on any residential street within the Borough of Marion Heights for a period in excess of seven (7) days.

SECTION 3: No person, firm or corporation shall park a truck,

trailer, motor home, camper-trailer, camper or pickup truck with a gross weight in excess of one and one-half tons upon any road, street or highway within the Borough of Marion Heights unless that person, firm or corporation is engaged in a business or occupation which requires the temporary presence of said vehicle upon the streets of the Borough of Marion Heights. At the conclusion of said business the vehicle shall be moved from the streets of the Borough of Marion Heights.

SECTION 4: It shall be unlawful to occupy any camper-trailer or motor home for living or sleeping purposes or to cause any such vehicle to be connected to electric, water, gas or sanitary sewer facilities within the streets of the Borough of Marion Heights.

SECTION 5: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this chapter shall be fined not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
