

ORDINANCE #79

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Marion Heights, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, and is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section I

The following unopened streets located within the confines of the Borough of Marion Heights are hereby vacated: (1) Cherry Street from the western right-of-way line of Morgarten Street to the western right-of-way line of Russel Street; (2) Birch Alley from the western right-of-way line of Morgarten Street to the western right-of-way line of Russel Street; (3) Lincoln Street from the western right-of-way line of Morgarten Street to the western right-of-way line of Russel Street; (4) Elm Alley from the western right-of-way line of Morgarten Street to the western right-of-way line of Russel Street; (5) Walnut Street from the western right-of-way line of Morgarten Street to the western right-of-way line of Russel Street; (6) Morgarten Street from the southern right-of-way line of Oak Alley to the southern right-of-way line of Walnut Street.

Section II

Within ten (10) days after the enactment of this Ordinance the Borough of Marion Heights shall give written notice by United States certified mail, return receipt requested, to the personal address of the owners of all property abutting on the streets proposed to be

vacated.

Section III

As these streets are on a recorded plan of the Borough of Marion Heights, the Borough of Marion Heights shall also give thirty (30) days notice in the News-Item directed to all the owners of property abutting on the streets proposed to be vacated.

Section IV

This Ordinance shall become effective forty (40) days after the enactment thereof.
